Did you know Municipal elections have more influence on our properties, cost of living and quality of life than the State and Federal levels? So, let's make sure our State issued IDs, US passports or Military IDs and Voter Registrations are updated if we've gotten married and changed our names and/or have moved after last November. Besides the name change, you can update your information for your IDs online at <https://www.in.gov/bmv/licenses-permits-ids/>. Update your voter registration at or register to vote and apply for an absentee ballot at <https://indianavoters.in.gov/>. This has to be done before October 8th if you want to vote in this election.

Our voting location is located at the fire station on 86th Street next to Sham Parks swimming pool. Polls open from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Early voting will most likely be available starting a couple weeks before the election.
